Amount: One \$500.00 scholarship annually.

Date of Award: Thursday, May 5, 2005 at the Hyatt Regency, Princeton, NJ. Details will be provided.

• **Applicants must:**

1. Be a graduating senior.
2. Be a current resident of New Jersey
3. Have gained acceptance to an accredited technology education teacher preparation program.
4. Provide evidence of intellectual ability with an official high school transcript demonstrating a minimum GPA of 2.50.
5. Provide two (2) character references from someone who knows the applicant for at least three years (i.e.) a teacher, coach or school administrator, a community leader, an employer, or a member of the clergy.
6. One recommendation from a current member of TEANJ. Non-member technology teachers can clear eligibility by joining TEANJ at the time of this application (application enclosed).

• **General Guidelines:**

1. **All applications and supporting documentation must be received by March 31, 2005. Applications receive after this deadline will not be considered.** All application material becomes the property of TEANJ and will not be returned. Application information will not be used for any other reason except for the purpose of this award.
2. The selection of the award recipient will be based upon evidence of scholarship, merit, character, and leadership, as gained through the application materials.
3. The Selection committee will make the final selection at the April Executive Board meeting. Notification will be made to the award winner via official letter. All decisions are final.
4. The scholarship money will be bestowed upon the recipient via a check payable directly to the winner's educational institution. Validation will be solicited from the institution verifying receipt of the check.
5. The recipient shall agree that the scholarship funds shall be forfeited if the student (recipient) withdraws from the technology education program prior to the end of their second semester.
6. The award will be presented at the TEANJ Annual Conference Awards Banquet on Thursday, May 6, 2004 at the Marriott Glenpointe, Teaneck, NJ.
